Hi Terry,

On Tuesday, March 28, the NMS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a request for Chemistry 2990 (new course).

The Panel did not vote on the proposed new course but would like the following points addressed first:

- Break down schedule by week.
- Provide further information about the assignments: e.g. level of expectation, lengths, what are the “additional assignments.”
- The statement on academic misconduct mentions Quantitative Chemical Analysis and includes a URL that does not work (should be <http://studentlife.osu.edu/csc/>).
- The attendance policy confuses the Panel:
 - Perhaps specify that this is for unexcused absences.
 - “Any participation points will be forfeited in the case of an absence”: This statement gives the impression that course grade will be affected even before a student has used up his/her two permitted absences.
- Provide curriculum maps. (Four-year plans seem to have been provided instead of the majors’ curriculum maps.).

I will return the course via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address the points above.
