Dear Professor Edwards and Ms. Banks:

The Curriculum and Assessment Subcommittee of the College of Arts and Sciences Honors Committee has approved your proposal for a new honors course, Music 3364E (Musical Citizenship: Activism, Advocacy and Engagement in Sound Music). The course will next be referred to University Honors & Scholars. Honors & Scholars has up to two weeks to review the course. Assuming approval by all of the appropriate curricular bodies, you may offer the course at your discretion.

In extending their approval, the members of the Curriculum and Assessment Subcommittee of the College of Arts and Sciences Honors Committee asked that I pass along the following recommendations:

- The committee thought it would be important to clarify with students taking the honors embedded version of the course how and when they should refer to the additional course readings and audiovisual examples they are assigned in the larger group discussions. The committee felt that references to the additional materials could be confusing for students taking the non-honors version of the course. The committee thought this was critical since the course is so centered around dialogue and group discussion.
- The committee recommends clarifying for students taking the honors embedded version of the course whether additional meetings with the instructor will be on an individual basis or as a group.
- The committee recommends including a brief summary of the statement of qualitative difference for students in the 3364E syllabus.

The subcommittee members believe your course will be a welcome addition to the honors curriculum, and they wish you the very best with what they are certain will be a rewarding experience for you and your students.
