Dear Professor Mitzen and Mr. Smith:

The Curriculum and Assessment Subcommittee of the College of Arts and Sciences Honors Committee has approved your proposal for a new honors course, Political Science 4385E (Quantitative Studies of International Conflict). The course will next be referred to University Honors & Scholars. Honors & Scholars has up to two weeks to review the course. Assuming approval by all of the appropriate curricular bodies, you may offer the course at your discretion.

In extending their approval, the members of the Curriculum and Assessment Subcommittee of the College of Arts and Sciences Honors Committee asked that I pass along the following recommendations:

- Include the information about reaction papers that is found under the “Breakdown of Grades by Assignment” on the 4385E syllabus on both the 4385 and 4385E syllabi (additional description, page limits, and approximate due dates);
- Consider adding similar information for the replication exercise (on both syllabi) and the original research paper, particularly page limits and approximate due dates (on the 4385E syllabus).

The subcommittee members believe your course will be a welcome addition to the honors curriculum, and they wish you the very best with what they are certain will be a rewarding experience for you and your students.
