On Tuesday, September 8, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course proposal for Earth Sciences 5790.10 and 5797.10. Please find below the Panel's feedback for these courses.

- Earth Sciences 5790.10 (new course) approved with two recommendations and two contingencies:
 - o Recommendation: Remove reference to Carmen dropbox. This does not exist on Canvas.
 - Recommendation: The panel recommends removing the clause, "as appropriate to align with student performance and the distribution of student grades" on page 4 of the syllabus, which may confuse students.
 - Contingency: Attendance is not included in the grade breakdown. Are there any consequences for not attending?
 - Contingency: Panel would like to know if there is any negative consequence for a student who fails the seminar. The panel suggests a minimum grade requirement by the drop date, given that 5790.10 and 5971.10 are co-requisites.
- Earth Sciences 5797.10 (new course) approved with two recommendations and one contingency:
 - Recommendation: Remove reference to Carmen dropbox. This does not exist on Canvas.
 - o Recommendation: The panel recommends removing the clause, "as appropriate to align with student performance and the distribution of student grades" on page 4 of the syllabus, which may confuse students.
 - Contingency: The panel recognizes that the day-to-day activities will depend on many factors, but would like some examples (2 or more) of possible excursions from days 6-12.

I will return Earth Sciences 5790.10 and 5797.10 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
