Dear Professor Mitzen,

On Tuesday, October 3, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course proposal for Political Science 4143.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with two contingencies and one recommendation:

- Contingency: If the course will be included in any Political Science majors or minors, the department needs to provide a curriculum map.
- Contingency: The in-class quiz requirements on page 2 state "You will get one point for writing your name, and will be able to score full points if you have done the reading." This will be unclear to students, and it gives the impression that any students who have done the reading will automatically receive points for the quiz. Re-word this.
- Recommendation: the intended rank includes freshmen and sophomores. The intended rank should only be junior and senior.

I will return Political Science 4143 to the department queue via [curriculum.osu.edu](http://curriculum.osu.edu) in order to address the Panel's requests.
