On Wednesday, November 1, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASCC Curriculum Committee considered (1) a proposal to offer History 2720 (an existing course with GE Historical Study) fully in distance learning format and (2) a proposal to create a new course History 3724 (with GE Historical Study & GE Diversity-Global Studies).

Please find below the feedback of the Panel:

- History 2720: unanimously approved with recommendations:
  - Distance learning syllabus: p. 9: Remove one of the disability statements. Keep the one that is recommended by SLDS <http://slds.osu.edu/faculty-staff/syllabus-statement/>
  - In-class syllabus (1) uses outdated pre-semester conversion GEC goals and expected learning outcomes (request to use the correct GE Historical Study language included in the distance learning syllabus) & (2) includes two plagiarism statements on pp. 7-8.
- History 3724: unanimously approved

Since History 3724 is a new GE course, a GE assessment report will need to be submitted after two offerings of the course. (See my other e-mails.)
