On Tuesday, December 12, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a course change request for Speech and Hearing Science 6742.01 (after having previously discussed it via email).

The Panel did not vote on the course but would like the following points addressed first:

- If one compares the old and the new syllabi, one notices identical goals, objectives, assignments, and readings. Actually, readings even appear to have increased in the revised syllabus. Given that information, the Dept of Speech and Hearing Science should explain why there is a reduction of credit hours.
- P. 1 of syllabus: Use S/U instead of Pass/Fail. Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory is not the same as Pass/Fail. Since this is an S/U course, the proper terminology should be used on the syllabus.
- Explain what Grand Rounds are & why they are group presentations (or are they?).
- Disability statement is not the most recent and Student Life Disability Services moved over a year ago. Please update to the most recent disability statement. See ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual p. 14 https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf
