Janice Aski has looked over the revision for Philosophy 2680 and has approved the revised submission. The course has been advanced to OAA & OUR.

Since Philosophy 2680 is requesting GE status, I am including a reminder that the GE assessment plan will need to be implemented from the very first offering of the course and GE data will need to be gathered. As is the case for all new GE courses, after the second offering of the course, the Assessment Panel will ask the department to submit an initial report summarizing GE assessment results of those first two offerings (following the format in Appendix 10 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual [p. 126] https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC_CurrAssess_Operations_Manual.pdf). The Assessment Panel and/or our office can help the department with any aspect of the GE assessment requirement. Shelby Oldroyd, ASC Curriculum and Assessment Assistant, will also make sure to contact the department before the course is offered and provide any assistance that may be needed with assessment. This week, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course proposal for Philosophy 2680 with GE Cultures and Ideas.

The Panel approved the course with one contingency and one recommendation:

- Contingency: GE assessment plan: The questionnaire should have a separate question for each Expected Learning Outcome (ELO) of the requested GE category. It is not clear how assessment differs for each ELO in the questionnaire. As for the final exam, the questions do not reflect or measure success in the ELOs.
- Recommendation: There is no absence policy. The Panel strongly recommends a clear statement of the implications (in terms of grade) of missing classes.

I will return the course via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address the points above.
