On Thursday, January 18, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to reduce the number of credit hours for cross-listed courses Molecular Genetics & Biochemistry 5701 from 4 to 3 credits. This review followed an initial e-mail conversation about the course requests by the panel members in early December. The faculty chair of the Panel, Chuck Daniels, had then engaged in a conversation with Susan Cole, and answers to the panel's questions as well as a revised syllabus were obtained.

Based on this additional information, the NMS Panel unanimously approved the requests.

Both Molecular Genetics & Biochemistry 5701 will now advance to the Graduate School and OAA.
