Dear Ian,

On Thursday, February 1, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed EEOB 3310.02 (the hybrid version of EEOB 3310.01, an existing course).

The panel approved the course with the following comments:

- Form in curriculum.osu.edu: Why not electronically enforce the prereqs and exclusions? (Could you please let me know? I can make the change for you before I advance the course. On a related note, I will remove EEOB 400 in the exclusions--since it is the quarter equivalent of the course & OUR has requested that references to quarter courses be removed going forward).
- P. 8: Remove trigger warning because it does not apply to this course.
- P. 9:
 - Use proper disability statement: see p. 14 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual

 - "Your mental health statement": Encourages students to contact the College of Pharmacy Office of Students Services. This must be a cut-paste oversight as ASC departments would never refer students to an office of student services in another college. The paragraph also refers to "the quarter."

Could you please let me know your response about the question pertaining to electronic enforcement by the Registrar's Office (first bullet point)? I will keep the course in my queue until I hear back from you. (The other comments can just be implemented when the course is first taught.)
