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Dear Ryan,

On Tuesday, March 20, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reconsidered the proposal to revise the AAAS BA.

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved the revision with three recommendations:

- For assessment: It might be good to organize an exit survey focus group & individual meetings every year.
- Sample 4-year plan.
  - Make sure that students do their GE Diversity (2 courses in Global Studies & 1 course in Social Diversity in the US).
  - ASC degree only requires 121 hrs. The current plan includes a minimum of 122 credit hours.
- Include transition plan for students who are already in the major. (Most often, programs simply state that students currently in the major will be allowed to continue in the plan that they started with or opt for the new program.)

The only document that we ask that you provide now is the transition plan (3<sup>rd</sup> bullet point). Again, this does not need to be long. Could you please make sure to send this to me before the end of the week?

The proposal will next be reviewed by the full ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC). The next meeting of the ASCC is scheduled for Friday, April 6.
