Please remember that the GE assessment plan will need to be implemented each time the course is offered and GE data gathered. As explained on p. 81 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual

You will be asked to submit a summary of rubric scores using the blank table provided in Appendix 11 of the Manual, one paragraph of instructor reflection (which may include instructor's explanation of student scores, qualitative analysis of student growth and development, changes to be made in the course, etc.), three sample assignments (one low score, one average score, and one high score) together with the course syllabus, the GE assessment plan, and any other appropriate supporting information.

Shelby Oldroyd, ASC Curriculum and Assessment Assistant, will also make sure to contact the College of Social Work before the course is offered and provide any assistance that may be needed with assessment. On Friday, August 31, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed new course Social Work 2200S with GE Service-Learning. The Panel did not vote on the GE request but would like the following points addressed first:

- Please request concurrence from the School of Communication.
- P. 5 of syllabus: Describe Special Event project further. Also, under Grading Policy, it might be good to change the "Group project" to "Special Event" if those two are indeed the same.
- The proposal does not provide a clear description of the actual service-learning activities & why the S-L aspect of the course will be unique to Social Work (as opposed to, for example, a course delivered by the School of Communication).
