On Wednesday, September 19, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee chaired by Carmen Taleghani-Nikazm reviewed a proposal for new cross-listed courses Italian and Comparative Studies 3052 (with GE Cultures and Ideas and GE Diversity-Global Studies).

The Panel unanimously approved the courses with one contingency and one recommendation:

- <u>Contingencies</u>: Request concurrences from NELC & Classics (Modern Greek section).
- <u>Recommendation</u>: p. 5: Parts of the academic misconduct statement are repeated: e.g., fact that all cases of misconduct will be reported to COAM or link to Code of Student Conduct. Students are not likely to read multiple variations of the same statement.
