Dear Meg,

On September 10th, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Curriculum Committee panel reviewed a proposal from the Department of Statistics to revise their undergraduate minor.

As part of the new BS degree in Statistics, which began this autumn, the department introduced four new courses in the major. As a consequence of these changes the department has requested that three of these new classes (Stat 3201, 3202 and 3301) be used in the new minor to bring the requirements for the two degrees in line with each other. The department has also designed transition plans for students currently in the minor and for students wanting to transfer from the minor to the major

The NMS committee voted unanimously to approve the request and the proposal is now advanced to the ASCC with a motion to approve.
