On Tuesday, September 25, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new course request for WGSS 3200.

I am happy to report that the course was unanimously approved with three recommendations:

- P. 3: What if a student misses more than 2 classes?
- P. 5: Last line refers to “Carmen discussion.” Although some assignments are turned in via Carmen, there do not seem to be any Carmen discussion activities in this course (?).
- There are some outdated Art Education courses included in the curriculum map. (Shari Savage—the Panel’s chair—is a faculty member in AAEP and happened to notice that. We did not double-check any courses in other units.)

WGSS 3200 will now be advanced to OAA and OUR.
