On Monday, October 8, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) reviewed a course proposal for Molecular Genetics 2690. The next day, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASCC reviewed its cross-listed equivalent, Philosophy 2690. I am pleased to let you know that both panels approved the courses with one comment regarding the grading scale in the syllabus: D- is not a grade at OSU & F should be replaced by E.

As you will recall from the team-teaching cfp (which I am here attaching), courses submitted for the ASC team-teaching grant are first approved as curricular items (i.e., as courses) for inclusion in their departments' curricula. It is this first step that took place on October 8-9. Next, the full ASCC will review the proposal for possible team-teaching grants.
