Good afternoon,

On Tuesday, October 9, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal for a new course Comparative Studies 2420 requesting GE Cultures and Ideas & GE Diversity – Social Diversity in the US.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one contingencies and two recommendations:

- Recommendation: The panel recommends moving the disability statement and academic misconduct statement to a more prominent place in the syllabus before the schedule of class meetings.
- Recommendation: The panel recommend including more class time and/or readings about food security in the course.
- Contingency: The assessment plan should include the expected level of achievement and criteria for success (e.g. a rubric).

I will return Comparative Studies 2420 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
