

Program Change: Online MA Program in Art Education

I am writing to request a change in our current plan of study for the Online MA in Art Education. Our Department's Graduate Studies Committee recently submitted changes to our existing Ph.D. program plans of study that changed the requirements for students taking ARTEDUC 7000.10 (Concepts, Theories, and Issues in Art Education) and ARTEDUC 7000.20 (Concepts, Theories, and Issues in Arts/Culture Policy). Now students in AAEP's in-person graduate program will take both of these courses for 7 weeks per course. The prior courses were semester long courses.

ARTEDUC 7000.10 is currently a required course in the Online MA Program. The Online MA Program in AAEP is taken mostly by practicing K-12 art teachers, museum educators, and community arts educators who are interested in further developing their teaching practices through continued study. We would like to continue offering this course as a required course, but change the name and number to ARTEDUC 7000.30 (Issues, Frameworks, and Theories for Arts Educators). This name change mirrors our distinction that both this and our recently approved research course ARTEDUC 7200.30 (Overview of Research for Arts Educators) are courses designed for practicing arts educators. Changing this name will designate that the content, length of course and mode of delivery (online course) are different than our existing ARTEDUC 7000.10 course.

Our current requested changes to the plan of study include:

- 1) Adding ARTEDUC 7000.30: Issues, Frameworks, and Theories for Arts Educators to our existing plan of study (3 credit hours).
- 2) Removing ARTEDUC 7000.10 Concepts, Theories, and Issues in Art Education from our existing plan of study (3 credit hours).

This change to the plan of study will help to clarify the difference between our now 7-week course ARTEDUC 7000.10 and the course that students are taking in the online program which is a semester long course.
