The Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASCC recently e-voted on a proposal to create a new course Speech and Hearing Science 6770.

The proposal was unanimously approved with the following recommendations:

- 1. Class policies on page 7 of the syllabus say that "Regular attendance is expected, although not recorded." The grading section on page 4 states that students are expected to attend 12 of 14 classes. The panel recommends clarifying this.
- 2. Change the "course length" section on the curriculum form to reflect the planned offering lengths rather than selecting all options. As Christina Roup discussed with you, the course offering lengths will be changed to 14, 12, & 7 weeks before advancing.

Speech and Hearing Science 6770 will now be advanced to the next step.
