Dear Yoon and Chris,

On Thursday, March 7, the Natural and Mathematical Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal for new course Statistics 4911.

I am happy to report that the Panel unanimously approved the course with 5 recommendations (for when the course is taught):

- P. 1: Length of lectures is stated as “Tuesday and Thursday, 12:45 PM – 2:35 AM”. The latter should be corrected to PM.
- P. 2: D- is not used at OSU.
- P. 3: Outline of Topics and Activities: The heading of the third column is more than likely not “Deadlines.”
- P. 4: Consider making attendance more mandatory since the course is mostly teamwork. If students do not attend class, this might hurt their group members.
- Likewise, for all group work, consider including differential grading depending on individual effort. Indeed, 60% of the course grade is group work and it seems appropriate to make sure that individual effort is rewarded.

The course will now be advanced to OAA & OUR.
