The SBS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee recently e-voted on new course Sociology 5950 (to be offered 100% at a distance).

The Panel unanimously approved the course with four contingencies and four recommendations:

- <u>Contingencies</u>:
 - Descriptions of the various assignments should be provided.
 - Specify whether the weekly discussion posts account for class participation.
 - P. 6 describes policies for "quizzes and exams," yet there are no quizzes or exams included in the course assignment table; this needs to be clarified.
 - P. 7 refers to group projects, but it is unclear whether there actually are any in this course.
- <u>Recommendations</u>:
 - Clarify how the office hours happen. Are there live online sessions during that time, or will the instructors just be available for emailing?
 - P. 2: Mode of delivery: "This course is 100% online. There are no required sessions when you must be logged in to Carmen at a scheduled time." Might there be a clearer way to state this?
 - P. 2 under attendance: Clarify who students should contact. There are references to "me" here, but there are two instructors of record.
 - Prefer ASC & SLDS approved disability statement included here <u>https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/asc-syllabus-elements</u>
