On Wednesday, October 2, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel reviewed two new course requests for the Dept of Classics: Classics 5883.01 and 5883.02.

The Panel did not vote on the courses but would like the following points addressed first (for both courses):

- Form in curriculum.osu.edu: Why make courses repeatable? Why allow students to take courses twice in same term?
- The syllabi need information on assignments and grading. (See here: https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/asc-syllabus-elements
- P. 2 indicates that the "course meets twice for two-hour spans." This cannot be. A 3-credit course that meets twice a week would need to have two meetings of 80 minutes each.
- Since the courses will be compulsory for graduate students in the department, a PhD program revision should be submitted as well, correct?

I will return the courses via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address the points above.
