On Tuesday, October 8, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed two course requests that accompany the Art BFA revision:

- Art 4999 (course change; remove decimalization & reduce credit hours from 3 to 1): unanimously approved
- Art 5000 (new course): unanimously approved with one contingency, namely:

The form in curriculum.osu.edu indicates that this is a lecture, but p. 1 of the syllabus indicates that "the time commitment is roughly analogous to a studio class" and this statement creates some confusion. Please look at the definition of credit hour on pp. 16-17 of the ASC Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual <a href="https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC\_Curriculum\_and\_Assessment\_Operations\_Manual.pdf">https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/asccas.osu.edu/files/ASC\_Curriculum\_and\_Assessment\_Operations\_Manual.pdf</a>. If the class will have an average of 1 hour of homework every week & the time commitment is indeed roughly analogous to a studio class, then the class should meet for 6 hours every week. However, this might be very challenging to implement considering that p. 1 also indicates that "the class meets once per week." Please include the number of contact hours for Art 5000. Consider removing the sentence about a studio class if it is incorrect.

Art 4999 has been advanced to the next level. As for Art 5000, I will return the course via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the department to address the point above.
