Dear all,

This note to confirm that on Friday, October 25, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) reviewed a proposal for new course Sociology 5925 & unanimously approved it.

The Panel members did have two recommendations (for when the course is taught), namely:

- P.6: In the pre-course reflection description, the following sentence appears: “Students should do any research when answering these questions.” It is more than likely that a “not” should be included in this sentence.
- P.9: Edit the academic integrity policy to fit this specific course by removing the reference to the midterm and the final.

As Kristi knows, we advanced the course the same day, & I see that the Registrar’s office entered it into SIS on October 29.
