This week, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee e-voted on a request to change the grading basis from S/U to letter grade for Sociology 4189.03.

Please find below the feedback of the panel:

- Important comment: The old syllabus includes the goals and ELOs for four GE categories: Writing and Communication (Level 1 and Level 2), Historical Study, and Social Science—Individuals and Groups. However, the course was never a GE course. The inclusion of the GE language with an explanation of how the course fulfilled the GE ELOs would have been a source of confusion for the students taking the course.
- <u>Contingency</u>: On the new syllabus, add the E grade range.
- Recommendations: On the new syllabus:
  - o P. 2: There is no "standard Ohio State grading scale." This is simply a grading scale that is widely used.
  - o P. 3: Adjust the font size for the disability statement to 16 point.

I will return the course proposal via curriculum.osu.edu in a minute to enable the Department to address the contingency of the panel.
