The request was unanimously approved with one contingency and two recommendations:

• <u>Contingency</u>: Deadlines for all the assignments should be clearly identified in either the syllabus description or on the schedule. So that includes the discussion board posts and the

quizzes. Also, note that there are only three critical thinking assignments in the syllabus description (see p. 4), but the course schedule lists four.

## • Recommendations:

- The syllabus might provide an example of a critical thinking assignment and the general expectations for an acceptable response.
