On Monday of this week, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed your proposal for a new first-year seminar, "Representing Refugees: Displacement and Migration in Media and Popular Culture."

The Panel did not vote on the proposal as they would like the following points addressed first:

- The sample proposal leaves out many crucial aspects of a syllabus: for example,
 - What are the readings (provide at least examples of readings).
 - Flesh out the activities in the seminar.
 - Provide more information about the graded assignments. Is the whole grade based on the portfolio? Provide more information about the expectations for the portfolio.
 - Include grading information/criteria for the different assignments.
 - Is this seminar S/U or letter graded?
 - Include the standard statement on academic misconduct.
 - Include the standard statement about disability services.
