The request to offer AAAS 1122 (existing course with GE Historical Study & GE Diversity—Global Studies) fully online was reviewed by the Arts and Humanities 1 panel yesterday. The panel unanimously e-voted to approve this request.

The panel had two small recommendations, which I here report:

- Office hours technology on the first page of the syllabus lists CarmenConnect, but then on page 3 CarmenZoom is mentioned. In actuality, CarmenConnect has been replaced by CarmenZoom.
- The course description on p.1 of the syllabus refers to "public health issues, specifically the HIV/AIDS pandemic," but there doesn't seem to be much in the syllabus on this subject.

As you requested, I have added all the campuses for this course. (Please know this means that AAAS 1122—taught in person or via distance learning—can be taught on any campus starting Autumn 2020. Curriculum.osu.edu and SIS do not treat campuses differently for in person and distance learning.)

The course change has been advanced & you will soon be able to schedule the distance learning version of the course for Autumn term.
