On Friday, August 7, the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) reviewed proposals to offer distance learning versions of the following existing courses: Spanish 4567 and 4567H.

Please find below the feedback of the Committee:

<u>Spanish 4567</u>: Unanimously approved with two recommendations (in italics below)

- Although there appear to be strategies for student interactions, there does not seem to be any scheduled time with the instructor. We recommend periodic instructorstudent synchronous interactions.
- o Language for late assignments should be relaxed in light of COVID.

Spanish 4567H: Unanimously approved with two recommendations (in italics below)

- Although there appear to be strategies for student interactions, there does not seem to be any scheduled time with the instructor. This is an honors course and, therefore, we particularly recommend that the instructor increase synchronous interactions with students.
- Language for late assignments should be relaxed in light of COVID.
