On September 3, the NMS Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to offer Math 5634 fully online.

The Panel did not vote on the request but would like the following points addressed first:

- How are students engaged in the learning experience (required participation activity) each week? The level of interaction with the students, the frequency and quality of student engagement in the course is not clear. What are the expectations for the students?
- How are students divided in groups if the course is asynchronous?
- Typo p. 2, 4<sup>th</sup> line: "on opportunity" should read "one opportunity."
- The panel asks that the ODEE syllabus template be used. That would make the information easier to read. This comment was already made by Ian Anderson in his feedback to the department.

I will return the course request via curriculum.osu.edu. Ian Anderson was present at the meeting and volunteered to work with the Department on a syllabus that conforms with the ODEE template. I am including him on this email so that you both can continue this conversation.
