Dear Professor Harnish,

On Monday, September 14, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to offer a 100% DL version of SHS 6771.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with two contingencies:

- The format of the course is unclear. Are there synchronous sessions? Are the speakers recorded or part of synchronous sessions? Class time and live sessions are mentioned (e.g. pages 4 and 5), but no indication is given on the syllabus of a scheduled time. This issue needs to be clarified, and the syllabus should be revised accordingly.
- Academic integrity: It is not clear enough how much students can work with others. Individual assignments need to be specific with respect to academic integrity (e.g. clarification on originality, group work, using work from other classes, etc.).

I will return SHS 6771 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
