In this document, I include four essential requests for the School of Music's Bachelor of Music Education degree program. Additional requests that are less urgent will follow and before the end of May.

1. A request to raise the overall GPA for students who are accepted in the program from 2.75 to 3.0 GPA.

Several years ago, the music education area voted to raise the minimum cumulative GPA requirement for the Bachelor of Music Education major from 2.75 to 3.0. The area operated on the assumption that the request had been approved; however, I recently learned that the proposal had not been submitted for ASC approval.

<u>Rationale</u>: The music education area believes that its students should be prepared both musically and academically to teach multi-age (i.e., PK-12) learners. Following a fundamental belief that a 2.75 GPA is an inappropriate indicator of teachers' preparedness and competence to teach multi-age learners, we request a change from 2.75 to 3.0 GPA requirement for acceptance to the BME program.

By raising the overall GPA requirement to 3.0. the BME program indicators for teacher preparedness will be consistent with the minimum 3.0 music course requirement for the major.

The music education area would like the minimum 3.0 GPA to go into effect in Summer 2022. However, currently enrolled students will be able to advance through the program with a 2.75 cumulative GPA.

2. A Request to add a of selection EHE Course Options to the BME program.

The music education faculty received notice from the College of EHE that due to a reduction in the unit's teaching force, fewer sections of ESPHE 4403 will be available for students in music education and other teacher education degree programs. The College of Education and Human Ecology suggested the following options for ESPHE 4403 and we ask to add the course options to the BME curriculum sheet:

ESPHE 4403 – Ethics and the Professional Context of Teaching (3 cr)

OR

ESPHE 3206 – School and Society (3 cr)

OR

I have edited the revised BME curriculum sheets to reflect the request.

3. Edits to the BME Choral, General Music and Instrumental curriculum sheets:

a. Voice majors in the School of Music have limited choices to meet the current small ensemble requirement; consequently, the music education faculty requests to modify the current ensemble requirement on the BME Choral and General Music curriculum sheets. The current statement reads: "Music 2208.XX Small Ensemble." The modified statement is identical to the requirement for Bachelor of Music (BM) Voice majors: "2208.02 Small Ensemble Voice or 2203.xx Univ. Choirs"

The music education area requests to adopt the requirement and statement for its choral and general music education majors. The revised statement appears in red font on the Bachelor of Music Education Choral and General music curriculum sheets under the heading, "Ensembles: 8 units."

b. The instrumental BME small ensemble requirement should include, Music 2207.xx, a small percussion ensemble for percussion majors. I have modified the small ensemble requirement for BME instrumentalists to include 2207.xx as a small ensemble choice. The statement appears under "Ensembles" and in red font on the BME Instrumental and General curriculum sheets.

4. Correction for two errors that appear on the instrumental and general music BME sheets.

a. Under "Methods" on the BME Instrumental and General curriculum sheets, Music 2262.13 Conducting (Strings) appears as an option. However, the course is not available as an option for any BME major. That is, all instrumental majors must take 2262.11 Conducting (Instrumental).

I request to modify the statement, Music **2262.11 – Conducting, Instrumental OR 2262.13 Conducting Strings** with the following: **2262.11 – Conducting, Instrumental.**The correct statement appears in red font under "Methods" on the revised BME Instrumental and General Curriculum Sheets.

b. In the 2019 request to add music electives to the BME degree specializations, I incorrectly added "2" credits for all music elective choices on the curriculum sheets. However, Music 2297, an elective for instrumental and general music BME majors, is available for 1 credit. I have corrected one of the Music Electives for instrumental and general music education specialists to reflect the credits available (1-2 credits) in red font.

Proposal: Request to Modify the applied lesson and ensemble requirements for BME Jazz Principal Majors

Background and Rationale.

The Bachelor of Music Education Instrumental and General specializations require <u>jazz principal</u> instrumentalists and <u>concert</u> instrumental majors to take several units of applied <u>principal</u> lessons with a studio professor. Under the current requirement, the BME jazz principal must complete six units of applied <u>principal</u> classical study with a classical studio professor (2201.xx through 3401.xx) and 12 units of applied <u>principal</u> jazz study (2201.xx through 45XX.xx). It should be noted that <u>there</u> is no <u>analogous requirement</u> for the <u>BME classical instrumentalist</u>, although some might argue that a similar requirement for BME classical majors should become a future consideration.

Nonetheless, recent conversations revealed agreement between the jazz studies and music education areas, with both areas noting that BME jazz principals should be better prepared to teach jazz and concert bands to K-12 learners. Additionally, the music education and jazz studies areas agreed that appropriate preparation to teach jazz and classical music to young learners could be accomplished through two simple modifications to the BME major for jazz principals.

Proposal.

The music education and jazz studies areas request the following modifications for BME majors who are jazz principals. First, the areas request a modification of the current expectation for jazz principals to take 12 units of applied principal jazz lessons and 6 units of applied principal classical lessons (i.e., three semesters of applied principal lessons). The modification will retain the jazz studies requirement of 12 units of applied jazz principal lessons and require only two semesters of secondary applied classical lessons (Music 2200.xx for 2-4 units). The modification will remain true to the jazz BME student's primary interest, i.e., jazz studies, and the jazz principal's secondary teaching interest, classical music. I note the appropriately stated course description for secondary applied lessons (Music 2200.xx):

"Fundamental applied music instruction in areas other than a student's major or principal area" (Ohio State's Course Offerings Bulletin, 2020-2021.)

The second request from the music education and jazz studies areas seeks to honor an implied requirement that BME jazz principals should participate in a concert band experience. The areas agree that a BME jazz principal's enrollment in a concert band will provide the student practical and invaluable knowledge and understanding as a performer, learner, and observer of concert band instruction. The proposed modification will require BME jazz principals to enroll in a concert band for two semesters prior to student teaching. Additionally, the jazz area agreed to modify one of the jazz ensemble requirements and allow the jazz principal to substitute one jazz ensemble requirement for a concert band, thus reducing any negative impact on the BME jazz principal's time-to-degree.

With the above BME jazz principal modifications, the program requirements will include:

- Applied classical lessons:
 - o change from 6 units across three semesters (2201.xx-3401.xx) to
 - o to 2-4 units across two semesters of secondary applied lessons (2200.xx)
- Two concert band enrollments and the remaining ensemble requirements as they apply to jazz studies
 - 1-2 units across two semesters of enrollment.

These modifications would affect the BME Instrumental and BME General specializations. There are no BME Choral students affected, as we do not have any jazz vocal students.

The proposed modifications would become effective upon approval by the ASC curriculum committee to allow currently enrolled BME jazz principals to take advantage of the modified requirements. Additionally, the proposal allows jazz principals who entered the BME program prior to AU 2019 to choose the current program requirements *or* follow the revised ensemble and applied lesson requirements. All students entering the BME program as jazz principals in AU 2020 and beyond will follow the modified curriculum if it is accepted.
