Dear Morgan and Jeremie,

Recently the Arts and Humanities Panel 2 of the ASC Curriculum Committee (ASCC) considered a proposal to create Hebrew 5691.

The Panel unanimously approved the new course with one question: For the two sample syllabi provided, at least two journal entries need to be written in Hebrew. Does this course need a language prerequisite (at least for those journals in Hebrew)? Right now, no prerequisite is required for the course. Thus, someone interested in Hebrew literature and culture might enroll not realizing that some Hebrew language knowledge is required for the course.

I will wait to hear back from you before I advance the course to the next level. Please let me know if the course should have a prerequisite.
