Good afternoon,

On Monday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed distance learning proposals for Spanish 2320 and 1103. Please find below the Panel's feedback for these courses.

- Spanish 2320 (distance learning request) approved with three recommendations:
  - **Recommendation**: The Panel observed that group session protocol could use some clarification in order to make it clear to students what they would be discussing and/or responsible for regarding the group session found on page 8 of the syllabus. They also would like to make a friendly suggestion to make sure the instructor is incrementally monitoring student progress.
  - **Recommendation**: The Panel suggests adding additional information regarding the student/instructor synchronous sessions as found on page 8 of the syllabus as they feel as if it is not entirely clear what students should have prepared for these sessions.
  - **Recommendation**: The Panel recommends adding additional information regarding the student's final three course in the course, as found on the course schedule on pages 17-19. They feel as if it is not entirely clear what student/instructor expectations are for those final weeks and would like to see more details.
- Spanish 1103 (distance learning proposal) approved with one recommendation:
  - **Recommendation**: The Panel recommends replacing the GEC language, found on page 2 of the syllabus, with the current GE language for the GE Foreign Language category. Spanish 2320 and 1103 will continue through the approval process.
