On Wednesday, February 17, the Arts and Humanities 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a course change proposal for Linguistics 3601.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one contingency and four recommendations:

- Contingency: Include the required disability services statement, which can be found in the Curriculum and Assessment Operations Manual (https://asccas.osu.edu/sites/default/files/ASC_Curriculum_and_Assessment_Operations_Manual.pdf) or at https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements
- Recommendation: There are two GE ELOs for Diversity: Social Diversity in the US. On page 2 of the syllabus, it appears that a copy/paste error may have added lines to the ELOs, giving the appearance that there are additional ELOs. Please correct this before offering.
- Recommendation: Include information on the length of synchronous meetings.
- Recommendation: The Panel recommends updating the language under "Required equipment" where it mentions Windows 7+ to Windows 10+, as Windows 7 is no longer supported software.
- Recommendation: The Panel recommends updating the language around Title IX. Kellie Brennan is no longer the Title IX Coordinator. The most up-to-date language can be found at https://asccas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements

I will return Linguistics 3601 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
