Dear Susan and Professors Downey and Hayford:

On Thursday, February 4th, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed course change and renumbering proposals for Sociology 5608 and 5649.

The Panel did not vote on the proposals as they would like the following points addressed:

- The Panel feels as if they cannot currently evaluate these course change requests as they need to see the 6000-level course syllabus in order to compare the changes in the requested 5000-level syllabus. Additionally, the Panel would like to ask for a rationale for why undergraduate Juniors and Seniors can take this course, how it will prove beneficial to them, and how the course will cater to both undergraduates (for whom this will be an advanced course) and graduate students (for whom this will be an introductory course) equally.

I will return Sociology 5608 and 5649 to the department queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
