Here is a new pdf with the BA info removed and the current advising sheet attached. I've also fixed the new advising sheet in response to your comments, adding 3004 into Drawing and Painting Electives (oversight when it was removed from Drawing and Painting Requirements) and Ceramics 5502 has been removed from Ceramics Requirements and already resides in Ceramics Electives.

I have fixed the number of repeatable credits in Glass, thank you for pointing that out.

Regarding the total number of required credits in Art & Technology and Ceramics, it is 18, but there is an option: in Art and Technology, 4101 or 4401; in Ceramics 4002 or 4012. I have made the "or" bold in the advising sheet to (hopefully) make this more legible.


