On Thursday, September 16<sup>th</sup>, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed GE: Themes (Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World & Health & Wellbeing) proposals for English 3110, 3395, 3264 and 3161.

English 3110, 3395 and 3264 were unanimously approved with recommendations and contingencies. English 3161 was not voted on. For your convenience, I am cutting/pasting the feedback underneath my email as well attaching it as a separate Word document.

2. English 3395 (new course requesting GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World) **unanimously approved with one comment**
  - The Themes Panel would like to express that they found this course to be particularly well executed in relation to the General Theme Goals and ELOs.
3. English 3264 (new course requesting new GE: Themes: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World & Health and Wellbeing) **unanimously approved with one comment**
  - The Theme Advisory Group (TAG) would like to express gratitude at how improved the course appears in relation to the Health and Well-Being Goals and ELOs.
4. English 3161 (new course requesting new GE Themes: Health and Wellbeing) **not voted on**
  - The Themes Panel asks the department to provide more specificity in how the meets all of the General Theme ELOs and Health and Wellbeing ELO 1.2, as they are not convinced that the course thoroughly satisfies these ELOs in its current state.
