Dear Professor Ettlinger,

On Thursday, April 29, the Social and Behavioral Sciences Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a proposal to revise the Social Sciences Air Transportation major.

The Panel did not vote on the proposal as they would like the following points addressed:

- Page 10 of the proposal states “Social Science Elective courses that are also approved GE Courses can overlap with the GE category for which they have been approved,” and “Any Social Science Elective course that is not an approved GE course can overlap with the GE Social Science and GE Open Option categories only.” It is the understanding of the Panel that this policy is not an official part of the current curriculum. It should be explicitly stated in the proposal that this is being formalized in the curriculum, as this overlap of GE courses is typically not permitted. Additionally, allowing non-GE courses to count in the GE for GE Social Science or GE Open Option requires a petition process. This should be clear in the advising sheet.
- The goals in Appendix C appear to be for the entire Department of Geography. How is this major assessed separately from the department? Provide the expected learning outcomes for the individual program and the mechanisms and timeline for assessing the learning outcomes. Include a curriculum map outlining the learning outcomes and courses in the curriculum.
