On Friday, May 7th, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE: Themes proposal for German 3254H.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with one contingency and one recommendation:

- o **Contingency**: The Panel would like for the course instructor to identify readings for citizenship to include within the course syllabus and provide an overall reading list for the course.
- o **Recommendation**: We would recommend adding course assignments (or clarifying how existing assignments) that directly engage with them GE: Theme Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World) in order for students to be directly engaging with the Theme ELOs. Currently, the answers on the submission form seem to concentrate on topics and content, rather than assignments and activities.

I will return German 3254H to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's requests.
