Dear Shari and Lauren,

At its last meeting of Spring semester, the Race, Ethnicity, and Gender Diversity Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a request to add new GE Foundation: REGD to existing course Art Education 2600 (which will also have GE Foundations: WILL & LVPA).

The Panel unanimously approved the request with the following recommendations/questions:

- Since this course will no longer be a “second” writing GE course, it is likely that the department will wish to remove the existing prerequisites for the course: English 1110 & sophomore standing.
- The syllabus will also need to include the goals and ELOs for WIL and LVPA.
- P.1: Please do not refer to GEC, a pre-semester conversion program. (Also, “GEC” did not stand for “general elective course” but for “general education curriculum.”)
- Recommendation to clarify what the papers are.
- P. 9: Instructor should use the standard disability statement as found here <https://ascas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements>
- P. 10: Kellie Brennan no longer works for the university. Please remove her reference from the Title IX statement.
- The Panel asks that the university diversity statement (found at <https://ascas.osu.edu/curriculum/syllabus-elements> ) and land acknowledgment statement (found at <https://mcc.osu.edu/about-us/land-acknowledgement> ) be included in all syllabi submitted for approval under the GE Foundation: REGD category.

Please let me know what you would like to do with the existing prerequisite for the course. I can delete or change it while the course is in my queue. I will wait to hear from you before I advance the course request.
