Dear Bernadette,

Per our conversation on May 28, 2021, I wanted to let you know that we are submitting a Course Change/Course Proposal for ENR 2100/2101 that in combination will fulfill a Natural Science GE in the new GE. ENR 2100 is an existing Natural Science GE in the current GE (3 cr lecture). ENR 2101 is a new 1 cr hour lab course that in combination with ENR 2100 will fulfill a 4 cr Natural Science GE effective AU22.

As we discussed, I have added an explanation to the Comments section to this effect for both courses. For the existing course (ENR 2100), the updated syllabus and the GE Application form are attached in curriculum.osu. For the new course (ENR 2101), intended to be taught via Distance, the syllabus and GE Application form are attached in curriculum.osu as well as the Online Assurance Form and QM Review (ENR had completed these components prior to our discussion; from this point forward, we will use and submit the Distance Approval Cover Sheet). My understanding is that because ENR 2100 is an existing Natural Science GE, the review process for that component will be expedited through Arts and Sciences, with the focus on ENR 2101 and how the two courses combined meet the new ELOs for the Natural Science GE.

In addition, I have attached a spreadsheet to this message with the list of courses that you will be seeing come forward in the near future for our combinations to meet a GE in the new GE. All but one will be in the Natural Science GE. The exception is the two-course combination from Entomology that currently falls into the History GE.

Please let me know if you have any questions or need additional information. I very much appreciate working with you as we navigate the GE Implementation!
