Dear Bernadette,

Per our conversation on May 28, 2021, I wanted to let you know that we are submitting a Course Change/Course Proposal for HCS 2200 and HCS 2203 that in combination will fulfill a Natural Sciences GE in the new GE. HCS 2200 is an existing Natural Sciences GE in the current GE (3 cr lecture). HCS 2203 is a new 1 cr hour lab course that in combination with HCS 2200 will fulfill a 4 cr Natural Sciences GE effective AU22.

As we discussed, I have added an explanation to the Comments section to this effect for both courses. For the existing course (HCS 2200), the updated syllabus and the GE Application form are attached in curriculum.osu. For the new course (HCS 2203), intended to be taught via Distance, the syllabus and GE Application form are attached in curriculum.osu as well as the Distance Approval Cover Sheet. My understanding is that because HCS 2200 is an existing Natural Sciences GE, the review process for that component will be expedited through Arts and Sciences, with the focus on HCS 2203 and how the two courses combined meet the new ELOs for the Natural Sciences GE.
