On Thursday, September 30th, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Themes: Sustainability proposal for Anthropology 4597.03H.

The Panel unanimously approved the course with one contingency and one comment:

- **Contingency:** The Panel requests that the Sustainability Goals and ELOs be included within the course syllabus, as this is a requirement of the College of Arts and Sciences. - **Comment:** The reviewing faculty found the course proposal well considered and detailed. The course fits the theme well and constructively supports the ELOs with sustainability relevant assignments. The literature considered is relevant and timely to ground students in the theme; they offered that Jared Diamond's *Collapse* may provide students with further insights. Additionally, they would like to commend the Department for the amount of detail put forth within the proposal.
