On Thursday, September 30th, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Themes: Health and Wellbeing proposal for Pharmacy 2400.01.

The Panel unanimously approved the course with one recommendation:

- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty offer the friendly recommendation of diversifying the stories of addiction used, as they are concerned that students will read the stories provided (which appear to be three stories of white men) and view them as universal stories of addiction. The reviewing faculty also would like to make a friendly suggestion to include materials, in the social aspect of the course, around addiction being very much a class/race issue in the United States in order to further help diversify the syllabus.

Pharmacy 2400.01 will continue through the approval process.
