On Thursday, January 27th, the Arts and Humanities 2 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed proposals for Music 7814 and 7815. Please see the Panel's feedback for the courses below:

- Music 7814 was not voted on as the Panel would like the following feedback items addressed:
 - After having a rigorous discussion regarding the resubmission of the course, the Panel has decided they would like to invite Tim Leasure, Director of Graduate Studies in the School of Music, to further explain the proposal and have a conversation with the Panel. An invitation will be sent to Dr. Leasure to attend the next Arts and Humanities 2 Panel meeting, and he has agreed to attend the next Arts and Humanities 2 Panel meeting.
- Music 7815 was unanimously approved with one recommendation. As a reminder, the Panel's recommendation do not need to be implemented until the course is next taught.
 - **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends updating the Title IX statement in the course syllabus, as the Title IX Coordinator listed, Kellie Brennan, has left the University.
