## Good morning,

On Friday, February 24<sup>th</sup>, the Themes 1 Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World proposal for EDUTL 5005.

I am pleased to report that the Panel unanimously approved the revision with one contingency and two recommendations. As a reminder, the Panel's contingency must be satisfied in a revision submitted to curriculum.osu.edu while the Panel's recommendations may be implemented when the course is next taught.

- **Contingency:** The reviewing faculty ask that a brief rationale be added into the course syllabus underneath the General Education Goals and ELOs (on pages 3 and 4 of the syllabus) that tells students how they can expect to fulfill the General Education ELOs. This is a requirement of all General Education course syllabi.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend removing the reference to the quarter systems prerequisite on the course syllabus (on page 2), as it has been removed in the curriculum.osu.edu portal system.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend removing the reference to a midterm and final exam (on page 5 of the course syllabus, underneath the Course Requirements chart).

I will return EDUTL 5005 to the departmental queue via curriculum.osu.edu in order to address the Panel's above feedback.
