On Thursday, October 14th, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World proposal for Education: Teaching & Learning 5005.

The Panel did not vote on the proposal, as they'd like the following concerns addressed:

- The reviewing faculty found this proposal to be an excellent course on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) but would like to see additional information surrounding the Citizenship portion of the GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World.
 - Additionally, they ask that the information surrounding Citizenship that is described in the GE submission forms be translated onto the syllabus and into course assignments, as this will allow a more explicit link to Citizenship to be established for students enrolled within the course.
