On Thursday, October 14<sup>th</sup>, the Themes Panel of the ASC Curriculum Committee reviewed a new GE Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World proposal for English 2276.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with two recommendations and one comment:

- **Comment:** The reviewing faculty found this proposal to be an impactful 2000-level submission to the GE Theme category and found the emphasis on public discourse as a mode of citizenship to be particularly impactful.
- **Recommendation:** The reviewing faculty recommend removing the grade of D- from the syllabus, as the University does not officially award the grade of D- to students.
- **Recommendation:** On page 6 of the syllabus, under the GE Theme ELOs chart, ELOs 1.1 and 1.2 do not appear to be the correct Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World ELOs and the reviewing faculty ask that these be changed to the correct ELOs. English 2276 will continue through the approval process.
