On Tuesday, November 2nd, the Race, Ethnicity and Gender Diversity (REGD) Panel of the ASCC reviewed a new REGD proposal for WGSS 2305.

The Panel unanimously approved the request with the following two recommendations:

- **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends adding an explanation of how the course will connect the course ELOs to the GE ELOs and suggests moving the course learning outcomes below the GE ELOs in the course syllabus.
- **Recommendation:** The Panel recommends explicitly stating that students will be grappling with race, ethnicity and gender within the course description in order to clue students in that this course fits the REGD category.
